However, if you don't have the app set up to automatically download the media, you'll still see the play button and you'll be able to stream the video when it arrives, but it won't actually download automatically to your device. For that to happen, you must tap the download button in the lower left corner of the screen. WhatsApp has traditionally been a bit slow in implementing new features. However, in recent months that seems to have been changing a little bit. In October, for example, he added the ability of contact video calls, a feature that had long been requested. In addition, the WhatsApp update for Android also provides users with animated GIF support.
